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Snapshot

Geos Comparison

Tracxn Insights (1/3)

- Spain is the 16th highest funded country in Q3 2024. The top 2 countries which saw the most amount of funding are United States and India
- A total of \$146M was raised in Q3 2024, a drop of 65.43% compared to \$422M raised in Q2 2024, and a drop of 50% compared to \$292M raised in Q3 2023.
 - Late Stage witnessed a total funding of \$65.2M in Q3 2024, a drop of 54.66% compared to \$144M raised in Q2 2024, and a drop of 45.53% compared to \$120M raised in Q3 2023.
 - Seed Stage saw a total funding of \$23.6M in Q3 2024, a drop of 37.02% compared to \$37.5M raised in Q2 2024, and a drop of 49.66% compared to \$46.9M raised in Q3 2023.
 - Early Stage saw a total funding of \$57.1M in Q3 2024, a drop of 76.28% compared to \$241M raised in Q2 2024, and a drop of 54.4% compared to \$125M raised in Q3 2023.
- No unicorns were created in Q3 2024 and Q3 2023.

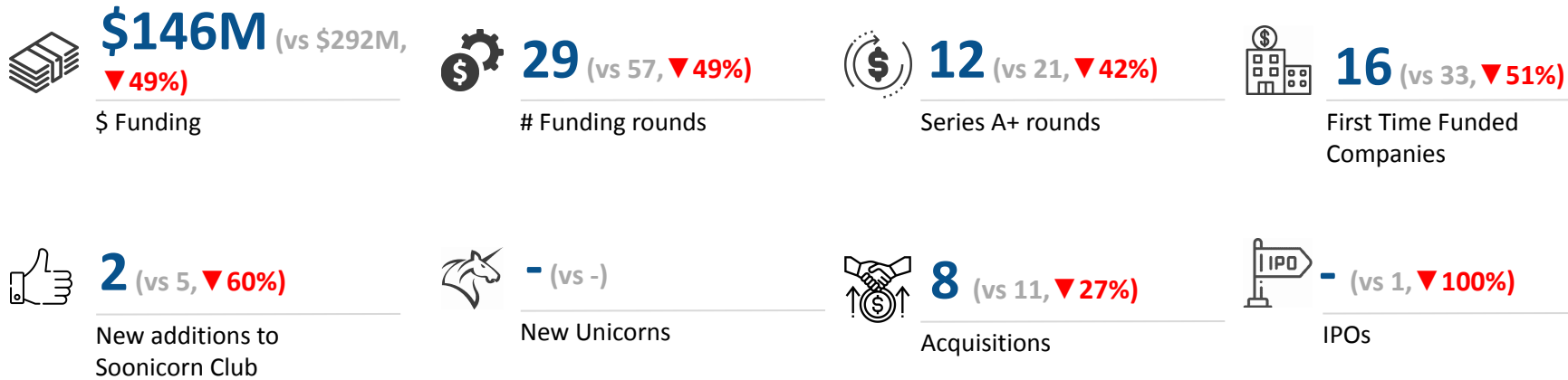
Tracxn Insights (2/3)

- Travel & Hospitality Tech, High Tech, and Food & Agriculture Tech were the top-performing sectors in Q3 2024 in this space
 - Funding raised in Travel and Hospitality Tech has witnessed a 31% increase in Q3 2024 compared to Q2 2024 and saw a rise of 262% compared to Q3 2023.
 - Funding raised in High Tech has seen a 75% drop in Q3 2024 compared to Q2 2024 and a drop of 69% compared to Q3 2023.
 - Funding raised in Food and Agriculture Tech has witnessed a 12616% increase in Q3 2024 compared to Q2 2024 and saw a rise of 14019% compared to Q3 2023
- There were 8 acquisitions in Q3 2024, which is 27.27% decrease compared to 11 acquisitions in Q3 2023.
 - GoSupply, Eos Connectivity, Incomee, Loccus, and 4GL were some of the companies that got acquired in Q3 2024.

Tracxn Insights (3/3)

- No companies went public in Q3 2024
- Barcelona leads the space in terms of total funds raised in Q3 2024, followed by Seville and Alcobendas
- Inveready, Caixa Capital Risc and Kibo Ventures were the overall top investors in Spain Tech ecosystem
 - EIC Fund, TLcom and Sofinnova Partners were the top seed-stage investors in Spain Tech ecosystem for Q3 2024
 - Seaya, Cathay Innovation, and Forbion were the top early-stage investors in Spain Tech ecosystem for Q3 2024



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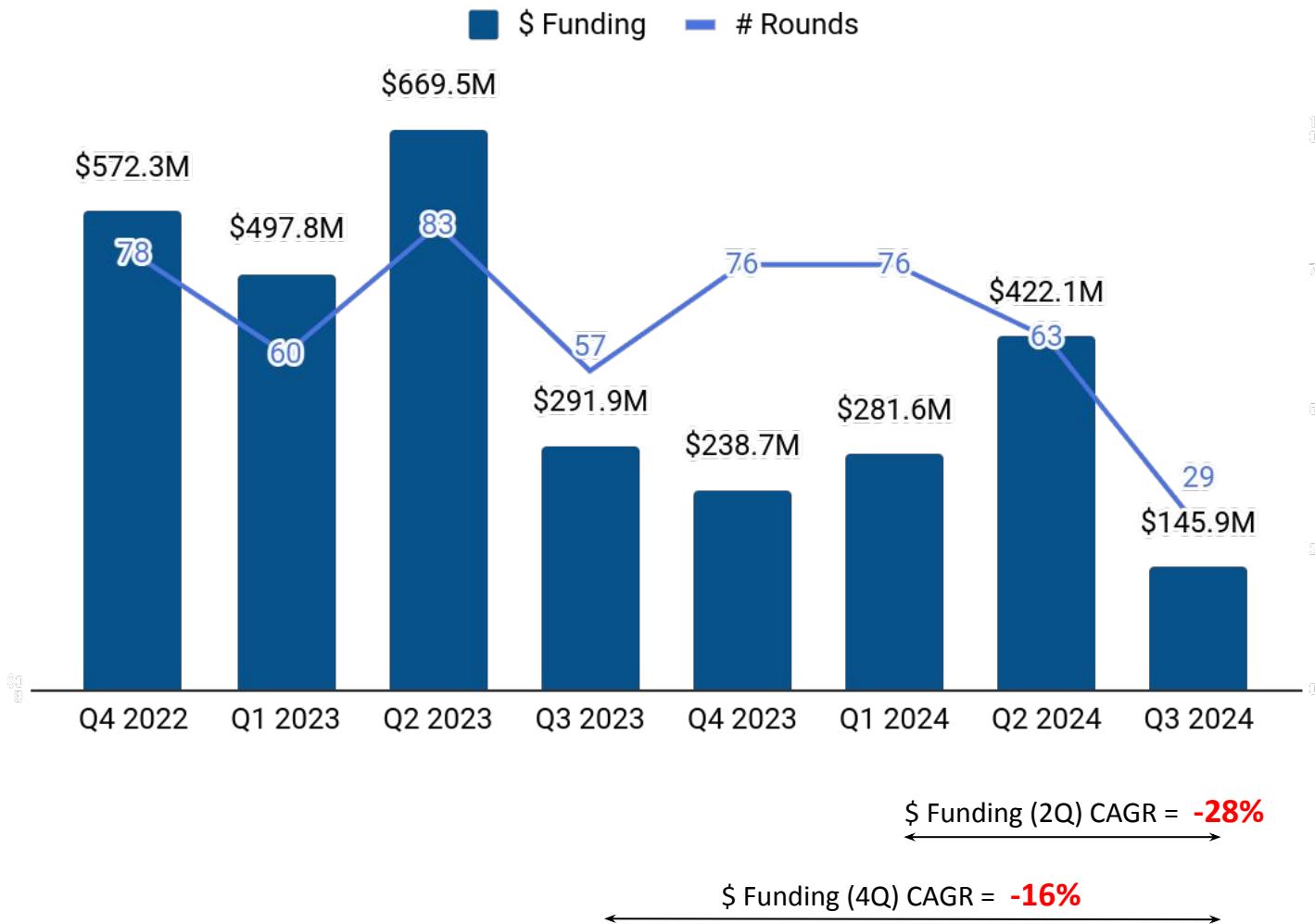

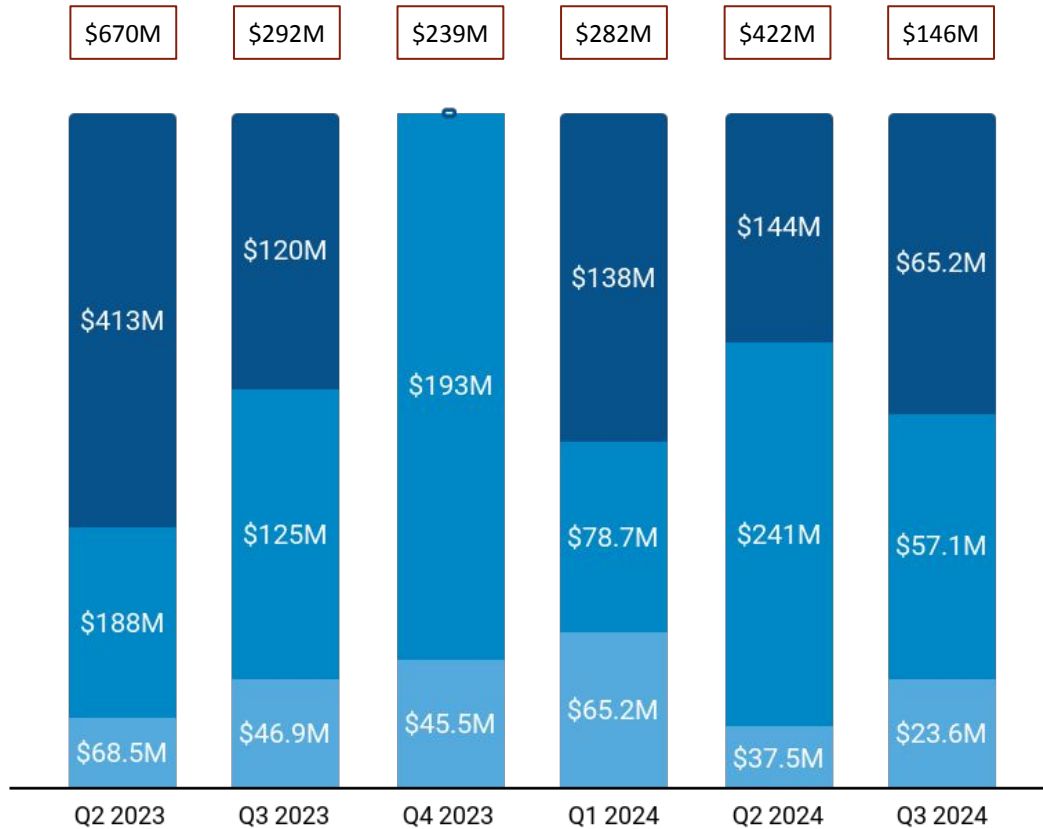

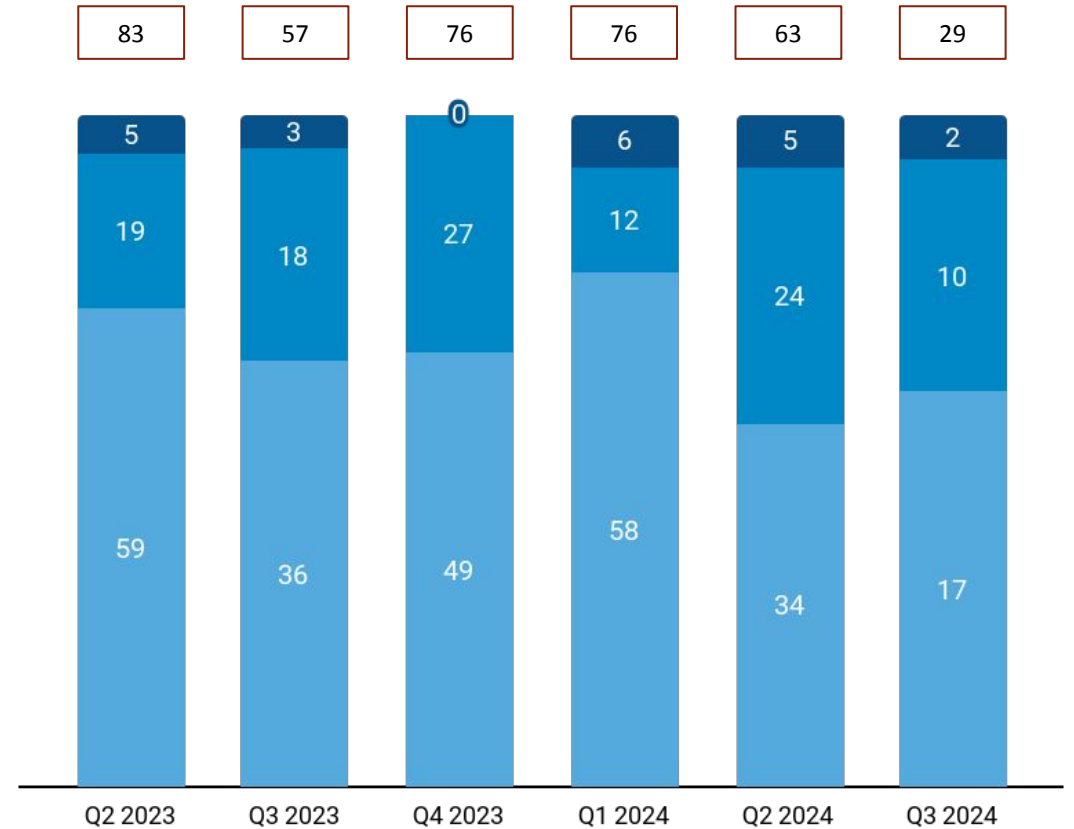

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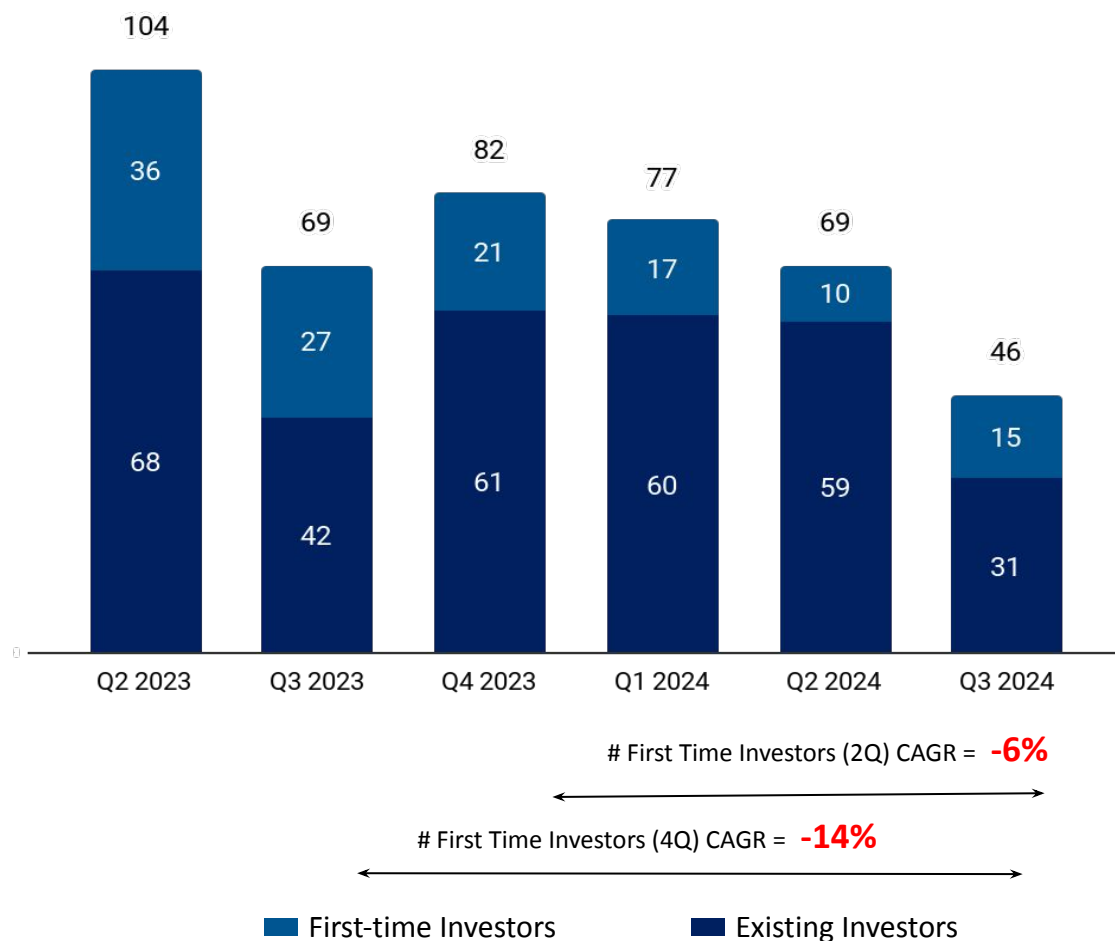

Q-o-Q # of unique Institutional Investors in Spain Tech



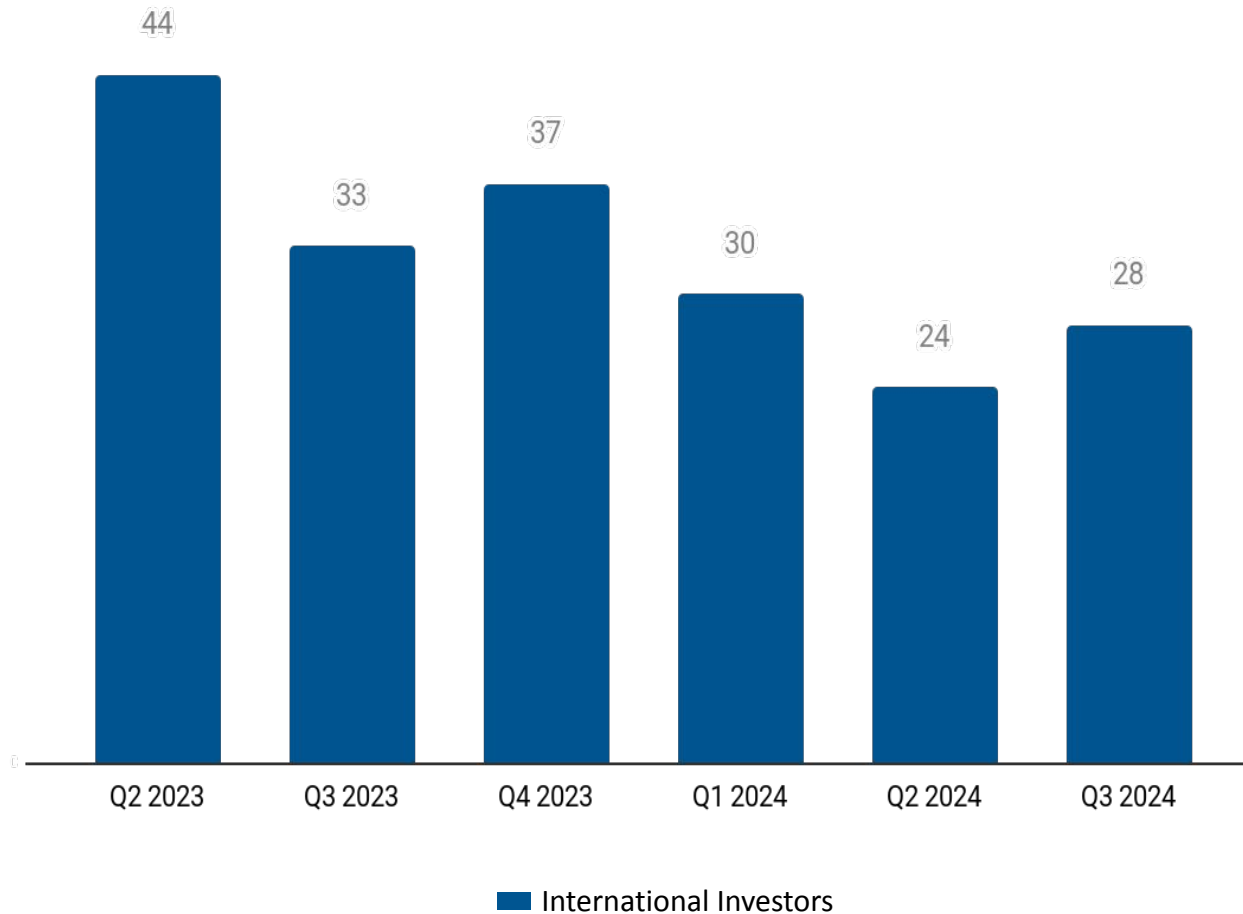

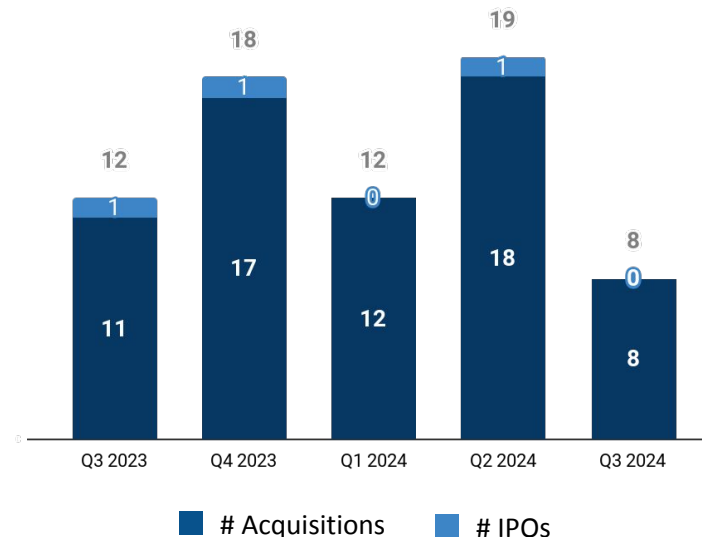

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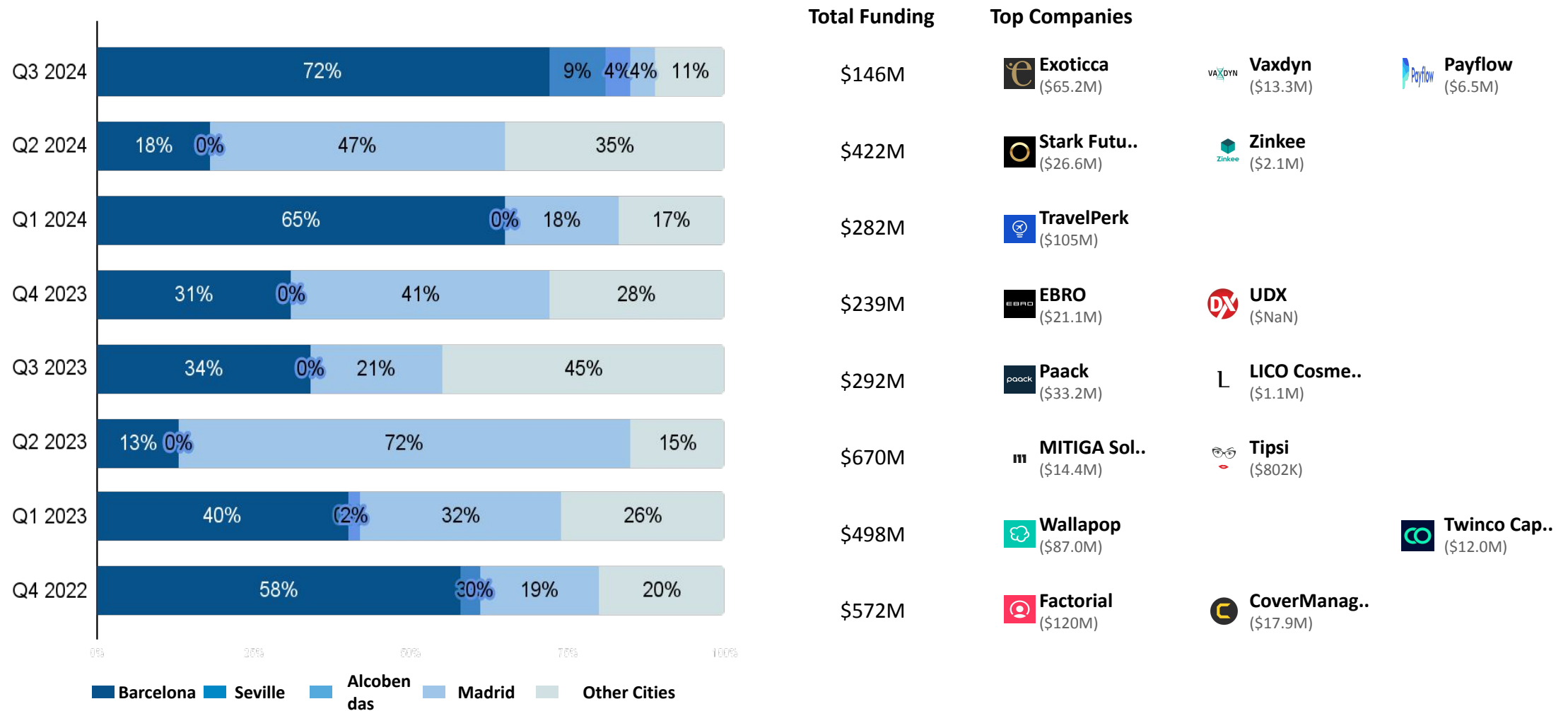

Cities by Funding raised in last 2 quarters
















Citywise Trends - Total Funding
